

The Verb Sentence:

الْجُمْلَةُ الْفِعْلِيَّةُ

Rule (600): The verb sentence starts with a verb.

Rule (610): The verb sentence is made of the following

فِعْلٌ + فَاعِلٌ + مَفْعُولٌ بِهِ

[or]

فِعْلٌ + مَفْعُولٌ بِهِ + فَاعِلٌ

Rule (620): The subject is either a noun or pronoun and it is always Marbo[^] (مَرْفُوعٌ)

Rule (630): The object is either a noun or pronoun and it is always Mansoob (مَنْصُوبٌ)

Rule (640): Both the subject and object can be nouns or pronouns. You can tell the difference between them by determining which one is Marfo[^] and which one is Mansoob.

Rule (650): The verb can be either one of the following:
