Translate the following sentences, make I'rab and put the Tashkeel on its words. I have done one example for you to follow. You don't have to provide the explanation, just do the I'rab.

أَعْرَبِ الْجُمْلَةَ الْفِعْلِيَّةَ التَّالِيَةَ وَشَكِّلِ الْكَلِمَاتِ

You^{2M or 2F} are planting the dates

أَنْتُمْ زَرَعْتُمَا التَّمْرَ

Using rule 810, we find that the possessive pronoun for "You ^{2M or 2F} " is "أَنْتُمْ".	ضمير فاعل Pronoun subject "You ^{2M or 2F} "	أَنْتُمْ
The subject is pronoun. Using rule 810, we find that the pattern for "You ^{2M or 2F} " is "تَفْعَلَانِ". Rule 820: The default case of the present tense verb is Marfoo^ with Damah	فعل مضارع مرفوع بالضممة. Present tense verb	تَزْرَعَانِ
Rule 630 says that the object is always Mansoob. Because the object here is irregular plural, rule 180 says that the haraka for Mansoob is Fatha. No Tanween because it has Alif-Lam	مفعول به منصوب بالفتحة Object Mansoob with Fatha	التَّمْرَ

They^{3+M} are harvesting the crop

You^{1F} are studying the lesson
