Summary of applicable rules:

1. Rule 1010-1: The past tense verb is always Fatha.
2. Rule 1010-2: The present tense verb is Marfo^.
3. Rule 1120: The subject is Marfo^.
4. Rule 1130: The object is Mansoob.
5. Rule 280: Singular nouns are made Marfo^ by Damma and made Mansoob by Fatha.
6. Rule 270-1: The Tanween for singular nouns exists in the case of no Alif-Lam.
7. Rule 270-8: When there is a Tanween Fatha, we put an Alif for the Tanween unless the last letter is Ta'a Marboota or Hamza.
